

Samuel Jackson Rainwater, Jr.

Samuel Jackson Rainwater Jr. was born on 8 May 1925, in Bennettsville, Marlboro, South Carolina and passed away on November 4, 2014 at age 89 in St. Charles, Missouri. His father was Samuel Jackson Rainwater, Sr. and his mother was Mary Eunice Grant. He married Edwina Marie McConnell of Kirksville, Adair County, Missouri on October 8, 1946 at Queen City, Schuyler County, Missouri.

Samuel's wife Edwina was born on November 3, 1919 and passed away on February 25, 2012 at age 92.
