THIS MONTH IN AMERICAN REVOLUTION HISTORY

The Battle of Monmouth, also known as the Battle of Monmouth Courthouse, was an important battle in the American Revolution. The battle, fought on June 28, 1778 in New Jersey, featured British forces under the command of Lieutenant General Sir Henry Clinton and Continental forces under the command of General George Washington. While the battle resulted in a draw between the two sides, the fact that the Continental Army held their own against the more experienced British troops proved that the colonial forces were becoming more effective in their tactics and discipline.  - e. Marvin Koechig and Dennis Hahn thanked Greg Landrum for his wonderful photography work at the convention

New Business:

- 1. Chapter Survey: Marvin announced that a survey will be created for feedback from chapter members on a location for the Chapter Meetings.
- 2. Nominations for next year's Chapter Officers:
 - a. Charles Lilly was named as the Nomination Committee Coordinator
 - b. Charles asked members to consider:
 - i. Who to nominate for positions
 - ii. To Consider and to express their interest in a position
 - c. Charles expressed the leadership's desire to not have anyone hold more than one position in the Chapter
 - d. Marvin Koechig expressed his intention not to hold the position of President next year
 - e. Jim Borgman expressed his intention not to hold the position of Treasurer next year

 - c. Charles and Stephen Baldwin will gather more information on the location of the graves.
